## **Breathe Bike Rodeo**

Breathe California Sacramento Region is proposing a partnership with The City of West Sacramento to host the first annual Breathe Bike Rodeo on April 30, 2022. This will be a family-friendly event with short bicycling routes, bicycling professionals, and safety experts. It will promote the health benefits of bicycling along with bicycling safety.

The proposed 1-mile route will take riders down Riverfront Drive, Mill Street, up River Walk Trail, and back to the starting point on Ballpark Dr.
